**Request for Expressions of Interest (EoI)**

1. Nepal has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Kathmandu Valley Water Supply Improvement Project for improving the delivery of inclusive and sustainable water supply for the population of Kathmandu Valley. Part of the proceeds (L-3255) is intended to fund eligible payments under the contract for which this Invitation for Expression of Interest is issued.
2. The Melamchi Water Supply Development Board intends to engage **one (1) Project Management Specialist (National Individual Consultant)** in accordance with the procedure of Asian Development Bank's (ADB's) Guidelines on The Use of Consultants by Asian Development Bank and its Borrowers, 2013.
3. The scope of consulting services of the Project Management Specialist will include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following items:
  - Provide project management, technical, implementation and monitoring assistance and advice to the MWSDB.
  - Effective and efficient implementation of projects components in accordance with GON and ADB's policies, procedures and requirements on project implementation, procurement, consulting services, disbursement, and social and environmental safeguards;
  - Procurement of works, goods and services (review of draft bidding documents; bid evaluation methodology and procedures, bid evaluation reports, draft contracts etc);
  - Early identification of critical issues affecting project implementation and suggest solutions for early resolution of those
4. MWSDB now invites EoI for **one (1) Project Management Specialist (National Individual Consultant)** to indicate their interest in providing the services.
5. The services to be provided by the Consultant are estimated to 13 person-months on continuous basis. It is expected that the consulting services will commence from 10 December 2021.
6. The Terms of References for the consulting service is accessible from ADB's consulting services recruitment notice (<http://csrn.adb.org>). Interested consultants are encouraged to submit their EOI through ADB's consultant management system (registration and access through <http://csrn.adb.org> or <http://csrn.adb.org>). The interested Consultants must provide description of completed similar assignments, work experience in the specified areas and relevant skills to show their technical and managerial competence to perform the services.
7. To ensure that all data required to assess for short-listing are obtained, interested consultant(s) are required to provide information following ADB's standard EOI form.
8. Interested Consultants can either submit their EoIs through ADB's Consultant Management System or in a hard copy to PMO by **26 November 2021** before **16:00 Hours**. Late submission will not be accepted.
